The Meeting was called to order at 7:06 P.M.

Minutes of November Meeting Bill Campbell made a motion, seconded by Julian Drelich, to approve the November meeting. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: No Report in the absence of Victor Lourenco

District Commissioner's Report: No Report in the Absence of Kevin Arnold

Referee Report: No Report, Binghamton area probably does not have a Referee Group President yet.

Entry Level Referee Course will be held in Dryden Jan. 20, Jan. 21 and Jan. 22. To be held at TC3.

Registrar Report: No report in Matt Palmer's Absence. Importance of getting ALL finalized team rosters to Matt by beginning of the outdoor season was stressed.

Spring League Coordinator Report: Bill Campbell Jan. 16 -12, Team entries Due, Feb 2-13 Last Day to Withdraw and Field Availability Forms are Due. March 15, 2012, Mandantory Coaches meeting, March 30, 2012 Free change period ends, First Day of Play is April 21, 2012, and Last Day of Play is July 1, 2012.

Mandantory Goal Requirement for U-10 and U-12 age groups is 6' x 8'. Field Size requirements are the same.

USYSA Changes: Required of all States, all age groups get only a Club pass with players picture and name on it. No signature required, no age group required.

Proposed: To add a rule, Coach with a Risk Management Pass that isn't executed (complete with signature and lamination) will be accepted with another Photo ID provided name in on the roster.

Game Report Forms ; suggestion is made again to request ref's names on 3x5 cards. When names are provided, refs are paid. Coaches need to make report on line.

Registration costs per team have not been determined yet. Fee most probably will be \$25 or \$30. Club registrations are paid with one check per club to Victor Lourenco by 3/15/12.

Outstanding Fines--at least one club is yet to pay.
